These Boy's High School records consist of faculty registers, class record books, student absentee lists, account books, directories, surveys, student maps, school programs, publications, and graphics. All artifacts have been removed from the collection and placed in the "Artifacts collection?"

Originally located at Whitehall Street in Atlanta, Boys' High School officially opened it doors in 1872. The school moved several times, to Courtland and Gilmer Streets in 1896, and finally to Parkway Drive at 10th Street in 1924. Portable structures were later added and shared with Tech High School. Boys' High School gave way to progressive education in 1947 when Atlanta's Public Schools became coeducational. Prominent alumni, featured in newspaper articles and photographs, are Georgia Governor John M. Slaton (class of 1880), Lucien Lamar Knight, founder of the Georgia Archives and History (class of 1883), and Dean Rusk, former U.S. Secretary of State (class of 1925).

Underground newspapers, e.g., <u>Flypaper</u>, 1927-1928; <u>Bugle</u>, 1910, 1938-1944, and no date; <u>The Ratler</u>, 1932-1934; and <u>Outlaw</u>, 1944-1945, competed with <u>The Tatler</u>. There are only two yearbooks, <u>The Alciphronian</u>, 1922 and 1936. Articles describing the history of Boys' High School appear in <u>The Tatler</u> issues of February 1, 1932, May 26, 1937, and June 2, 1947. The Atlanta Historical Society has additional <u>Alciphronians</u>.
