New Exhibit Opening Soon: *Sacred Chronicles: Exploring Georgia's Church Records*  
August 5 – November 4, 2023

The Georgia Archives exhibit, *Sacred Chronicles: Exploring Georgia's Church Records*, will open August 5<sup>th</sup> and run through November 4, 2023.

This exhibit will offer a unique opportunity to delve into the historical and cultural significance of religious institutions in the state of Georgia. Handpicked artifacts for this display encompass colonial records predating the founding of Georgia, meticulously maintained church minutes, memberships lists, and published histories from some of the earliest religious establishments in the region. Augmenting the display, an assortment of postcards, photographs, and archival documents will adeptly illustrate the evolution of diverse denominations across the state and highlight the meticulous preservation and microfilm initiatives undertaken to ensure the enduring survival of these invaluable church records.

The exhibit is free and open to the public during our regular research hours: Tuesday through Saturday, 9 am – 12 pm and 1 pm – 4 pm.
