

BURKE COUNTY

Created: February 5, 1777

From: Creek cession of May 20, 1733 -- an

original County previously organized

as the Parish of St. George

County Seat: Waynesboro

Courthouse destroyed by fire in 1825, 1856, and 1870.

"Some time around midnight on Thursday, January 24, 1856, a fire broke out in the Burke County courthouse in Waynesboro. The building burned to the ground, taking with it the vast majority of county records.... Burke County's record losses are considered among the worst in Georgia."






