

Note on fillable PDFs: Many of our forms have been designed as fillable PDFs. To use the fillable functionality, right click on the title and choose "Save link as" or "Save target as." Once you've saved the file, you can open it with Adobe Reader and fill in the form.

- <u>Six-Generation Chart (PDF, 418K)</u> simple six-generation family history chart
- . Four-Generation Chart (PDF, 317K) simple four-generation family history chart
- Family Unit Chart (PDF, 262K) two-page chart to detail two spouses and their children
- Individual Worksheet (PDF, 195K) worksheet to serve as a guide for biographical information about an individual
- Extended Family Chart (PDF, 518K) track your distant family relations including those who are "removed"
