- 1. There is a photograph of two Native American girls from Lumpkin County. What collection is the image contained in and what is the Record ID / Identifier for the photograph?
- 2. An African American couple, General Wilson and Jamie Johnson, were united in holy matrimony in Madison County in 1900. In which marriage book is their license included? What page does their marriage license appear in the book? Bonus: What was their wedding date?
- 3. Searching the Confederate Pension Applications Collection, how many results are returned when you complete an advance search for "Mrs" in Warren County?
- 4. Conducting a general search on the term "governor", how many search results are returned? If you narrow the search to the Ad Hoc collection, how many search results do you have?
- 5. In the Trademark Registrations collection, the trademark for Fly Tox is the thumbnail for the Trademark Registrations volume covering what years?

Bonus:

- 1. Search the Virtual Vault to look for items in your research areas. For instance, if your ancestors lived in Warren County, use Warren County as your search term.
- 2. Search the Virtual Vault for at least 2 surnames you are researching.
